

ORDINANCE NO. 16-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBDIVISION 4 OF
SECTION 701.05 AND SECTION 701.06 OF THE BALATON
CITY CODE TO ENACT WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The City Council of Balaton, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of Section 701.05 of the Balaton City Code is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

SUBD. 4. IMPOUNDMENT. The following motor vehicles parked in the ^{City} ~~state~~ are subject to towing and impoundment:

1. Any vehicle found to be in violation of the winter parking rules provided in Paragraph 701.06, hereafter.
2. Any vehicle parked in such a manner as to create a significant public safety hazard.
3. Any vehicle parked on private property without the consent of the property owner.

Any officer of the Lyon County Sheriff's Department may ticket and require the owner or driver of any vehicle parked in violation of this Subdivision to move the offending vehicle, or if the owner is not available, remove or cause the vehicle to be removed and impound the offending vehicle. Such vehicle shall not be released from impoundment until the fees for towing and storage are paid in addition to any fine imposed for violation of this ordinance.

Section 2. Section 701.06 of the Balaton City Code is hereby amended to read, in its entirety as follows:

701.06. WINTER PARKING. Winter parking restrictions shall be effective in the City everyday beginning on the 15th day of November through the 15th day of April in each year, and no motor vehicle shall be parked on any street or alley during that time period so as to interfere with snow removal, which restrictions are more particularly described as follows:

1. Business District Streets. No motor vehicle shall be parked from 2:30 am to 7:00 a.m. on Third Street between Lake Avenue and Washington Avenue or on Central Avenue between Second Street and Third Street.
2. Residential Streets, Alleys and Service Roads. No Motor vehicle shall be parked on any street or alley in a manner that would interfere with the removal of snow from the center of the street to the curb.
3. Boulevard and Utility Right of Way. No motor vehicle shall be parked on any boulevard or utility right of way adjacent to a public street.

Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective from and after the date of its passage and publication.
