

RECYCLING GUIDE

LOOSE (NOT BAGGED):

Recycle in Single Stream Bin

**ALL MUST BE
EMPTY OF LIQUID
AND FOOD WASTE**



GLASS

Food or beverage bottles and jars only.
Must be empty. May leave caps and lids on.



PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Bottles, tubs and jugs only.
Must be empty. May leave caps and lids on.
Any chemicals must be triple rinsed and dry.



CANS

Steel, tin & aluminum.



PAPER

No metal or plastic bindings.
No more than 2 phone books per pick-up, per resident.



CARDBOARD & CARTONS

Please flatten boxes.

BAGGED:

Recycle in Single Stream Bin



SHREDDED PAPER

Bagged separately in clear bag and knotted shut.



PLASTIC BAGS

Bagged separately in clear bag and knotted shut.

WHEN IN DOUBT, KEEP IT OUT!

KEEP THESE OUT

NOT RECYCLABLE IN THE SINGLE STREAM BIN



METAL & RUBBER

Tires, hoses, hangers, cutlery, pots & pans.
Check for alternative recycling options.



TOYS & CLOTHES

Gently used items may be donated.
(Textile recycling stations at Walmart and Hy-Vee
in Marshall and the Lyon County Public Works building)



WOOD & ORGANICS

Diapers, food, pet, & yard waste.
Check for alternative composting options.



STYROFOAM & "TO-GO" ITEMS

All foam and plastic to-go containers,
straws, napkins, candy and chip wrappers.



DISH, BAKING & OTHER GLASS

Ceramics, porcelain, pottery, pyrex, mirror, windows.
Gently used items may be donated.



HAZARDOUS ITEMS

Bring to HHW facility at the
Lyon County Public Works building.
DO NOT THROW IN TRASH.



NEEDLES & PILLS

Never place containers with used needles or syringes
in a recycling bin or loose sharps in the garbage.
(Find proper disposal options at lyonco.org)



ELECTRONICS & BULBS

Bring to HHW facility at the
Lyon County Public Works building.
DO NOT THROW IN TRASH.
