

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING FISHING ON AERATED
LAKES IN LYON COUNTY**

The County of Lyon does ordain:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. The following words, terms and phrases, for the purpose of this Ordinance, shall have the following meanings:

- (a) "Lakes" shall mean all the lakes that lie wholly or in part within the boundaries of Lyon County.
- (b) "Person" shall include an individual, partnership, corporation, or any batch of persons, whether incorporated or formed into an association or not.
- (c) "Open Water" shall mean water upon a lake without coverage of ice.

SECTION 2. SCOPE. In the interest of public health, safety and the general welfare, the following regulations are hereby imposed upon all persons using lakes lying and being in the above said county whenever an aeration system is operating or in place (or scheduled for operation) under a permit from the Department of Natural Resources.

SECTION 3. VIOLATION. Any person fishing, whether from shore or upon the lake in or around open water where aeration is in operation between December 1 and April 1 of each year shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of up to \$100.00.

SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT. The Sheriff of Lyon County is authorized to enforce this ordinance and to inform the public of the provisions of this ordinance by posting said lakes lying and being in the above said county in accordance with Department of Natural Resources rules, orders and permits.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval by the Commissioner of Natural Resources and publication.
