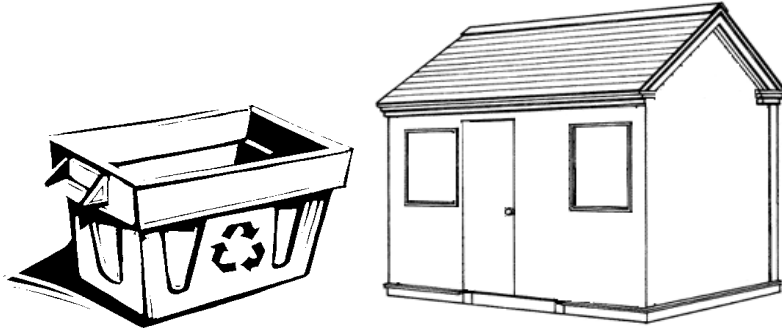









# Rock County Curbside and Shed

Bag in paper bags, box or bundle.	Break down and flatten boxes. Place paper bags inside another bag.	Rinse/clean. Remove caps or covers. No need to remove lables.	Rinse/clean, remove labels. Flatten if possible to save space.	Rinse/clean, remove caps, covers, or lids. Flatten to save space.
