Accepted Major Appliances include:

HVAC (Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning):

- Air conditioners
- Dehumidifiers
- Furnaces
- Heat pumps

KITCHEN:

- Conventional ovens/ranges/stoves
- Dishwashers
- Garbage disposals
- Microwave ovens
- Refrigerators/freezers
- Trash compactors

OTHER:

- Washers/dryers
- Water heaters

- 1. Keep hazardous waste out of our landfill.** Many appliances contain PCB's (a hazardous waste), and refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners have CFC's that contribute to ozone depletion.
- 2. Upgrading appliances to more energy-efficient products reduces energy consumption.**
- 3. Recycling metal components saves landfill space.** Metals and fluids are captured and recycled through a different company.
